Dear Ms. Faltz-Heath:

As I have received not even a confirmation of my October 26 e-mail to TIGTA that appears below, on Monday of this week I contacted IRS Territory Manager Mark Jaramillo to request his assistance in obtaining information on the status. He has since informed me that he contacted you, and you responded that my information had been sent to a field office. **I ask that you please furnish me the name of, and contact information for, the person to whom you forwarded my information.** I would greatly appreciate a response today.

I urge you to not underestimate the strength of my commitment to assure that this complaint is carried through to satisfactory conclusion on a timely basis. In light of the now four and a half month delay described in the October 26 e-mail below, compounded by the lack of response to that e-mail, my patience is nearing the breaking point. It is my observation that TIGTA does not recognize the seriousness of my allegations, which I believe to be reflective of felony level criminal activity on the parts of certain individuals within General Motors and the IRS.

Please understand that mine is no ordinary complaint. While my complaint to TIGTA only involves the seemingly conspired GM/IRS actions, there was the second unconscionable action involving the Treasury Department in 2009 whereby the Department's Presidential Task Force on the Auto Industry supported GM's virtual theft of my business in order to give it to its chosen minority dealer, a native of India. **One would find it hard to believe that this harassment and legalized extortion could occur in a corrupt third world country, let alone in the United States of America.**

Thank you in advance for your prompt response with the field office person's name and contact information, and for your future assistance in following the investigation through to a prompt conclusion.
