Dear Representative Stark:

I wish to express concern about the lack of progress on the TIGTA investigation I requested in my June 21, 2010 complaint, as well as TIGTA's apparent misunderstanding of the issue. I wish to make it clear that my complaint regards GM/IRS collusion relates to IRS audits performed on my corporation in 2005, and on me personally in 2007-2008. My complaint **does not** include the Treasury Department's Presidential Task Force on the Auto Industry's support of GM dealer terminations, although that action was also unconscionable. It is my understanding that SIGTARP is conducting a separate investigation of possible illegal actions by GM involving those terminations.

I sent my complaint to TIGTA on June 21, and delivery was confirmed to be on June 25. It is now nearing five months since I filed the complaint, and due to unexplained delays and TIGTA's misrouting of the complaint back to IRS personnel, it appears that no productive action has been taken. I sent an e-mail to TIGTA on October 26, and one on November 10 to TIGTA's Belinda Faltz-Heath requesting contact information for the person handling the investigation. Copies of the e-mails, which I believe clearly express my frustration, are enclosed. I have not received a reply to my November 10 e-mail.

As I feel that neither my complaint to TIGTA nor your supporting August 10 inquiry to the Department of the Treasury have been taken seriously, I respectfully request your issuing of a request for an action timetable, and for contact information so that I may contact the person responsible for the investigation. As I believe the GM/IRS collusion involves criminal activities that rise to the level of felonies due to the six-figure dollar amount, it is an issue that can wait no longer.

Thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter.
