Subject Matter/Remarks

On December 7, 2010, DONALD SIGNER, Taxpayer/Former President, Signer Buick-Cadillac, Newark, California, provided additional documentation regarding an initial complaint he filed on June 21, 2010, with the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA), in which he alleged that General Motors (GM) colluded with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to harass him into selling his business. SIGNER provided the following additional documentation:

A contact information list, which includes GM officials that SIGNER alleged may have been involved in collusion with the IRS.

A copy of a letter SIGNER provided to [REDACTED], Revenue Agent, IRS, Small Business/Self Employed (SB/SE), Oakland, California on March 1, 2010.

A partial copy of a January 27, 2009, Deposition of SIGNER, taken by a GM Attorney, concerning a lawsuit SIGNER brought against GM.
