Subject Matter/Remarks

On December 8, 2010, DONALD SIGNER, Taxpayer/Formal President, Signer Buick-Cadillac, Newark, California, provided additional documentation regarding an initial complaint he filed on June 21, 2010, with the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA), in which he alleged that General Motors (GM) colluded with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to harass him into selling his business. SIGNER provided the following additional documentation:
