

This is in response to your inquiry to Mr. Kim Wallace, Assistant Secretary for Legislative Affairs, U.S. Department of the Treasury, on behalf of your constituent, Donald R. Signer. Your correspondence was forwarded to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) on November 24, 2010. Mr. Signer alleges fraud and harassment committed by the Internal Revenue Service and General Motors Corporation.

The TIGTA Complaint Management Team received the complaint directly from Mr. Signer and acknowledged his correspondence on July 19, 2010. We received additional correspondence from Mr. Signer on August 26, 2010, and are continuing to review this matter. Upon completion of the review, to the extent allowable under the law, we will advise you of the results.

We appreciate the concerns raised by your constituent and thank you for following up on the matter.
