Dear Congressman Stark:

I seek your assistance in my obtaining responses to the following unanswered letters I sent to TIGTA personnel:

- July 8, 2011, to Daphne Levitas with copy to Timothy Camus
- August 5, 2011, to Treasury Inspector General J. Russell George with copy to Principal Deputy Joseph Hungate


My letter to Ms. Levitas requested clarification on the documents that continued to be withheld, as well as a review of those documents to consider releasing them to me. Toward this end, **I ask your assistance in achieving release of the remaining withheld information.**

As I described in the letter to Inspector General George, a primary issue in TIGTA's non-investigation is its classifying of my harassment complaint as a non-1203 violation allegation. As this appears to be in direct conflict with IRS documentation that unambiguously confirms that it is in fact a 1203 violation allegation, and thus a TIGTA responsibility, **I request clarification from TIGTA on how it arrived at its non-1203 interpretation stated in two "Complaint Referral Memorandum" forms.**

In the aforementioned letters, I stated my document-supported observation of a TIGTA cover-up by way of its non-investigation of my complaint, followed by an invitation for comment from the addressees. Despite the opportunity to refute my observations, to date none of the parties have responded, a fact that reinforces the strength of my observations.

Thank you in advance for your assistance in prompting responses from TIGTA officials.
