Dear Congressman Stark:

This is to request that you ask Chairman Issa of the Congressional Committee on Oversight & Government Reform to investigate my allegations of a TIGTA cover-up. I also ask that a credible investigation be conducted regarding my original complaint to TIGTA, but by an agency other than TIGTA. I furnished documentation supporting my allegations to Jason Teramoto of your office on August 31, 2011. TIGTA's actions were a result of my June 21, 2010, document-supported complaint I sent to TIGTA, a copy of which I furnished Jo Cazenave of your office in July 2010.


Rather than attach the extensive documentation to this letter, I feel it is easier to refer to my website, donsigner.com, which contains the story. While the website descriptions are structured somewhat differently than the documents I furnished your office, the content is effectively the same, and links to the supporting documents are included. The following shows where to find the subject items on the website, along with suggestions for comprehending the "big picture" in order to put everything in perspective and understand motives. I suggest reading items on donsigner.com in the following order:

1. Home Page (tab at top): This is a brief overview of the big picture.
2. Dealership History (tab at top): This narrative is in chronological order. IRS/TIGTA/FBI related paragraphs have the dates highlighted in red, beginning with "(2005 July #3)." I suggest a brief review of red dated paragraphs.
3. "Expanded Details" in right column: Click on link "(2010) Signer Reports Alleged GM/IRS Collusion to U. S. Treasury."
4. "Expanded Details" in right column: Click on link "(2010-2011) U. S. Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) Secretly Avoids Investigation of Signer Allegations."

The Expanded Details include links to many supporting documents. Both sections are lengthy, but the detail is necessary to explain the complex nature of each action. In my opinion, it is this complexity that GM, the IRS, and TIGTA all felt would prevent me from connecting the dots as I have done.
